The Pre-Primary to Year 6 classes is very fortunate to have secured Edu-dance for our Term 2 dance program this year. Edu-dance is a creative hip-hop dance program designed for primary school students, developed in Perth.

The program fulfils the Arts and Physical & Health outcome requirements of the students' curriculum and covers many other aspects such as coordination, musical appreciation and self-confidence.

Edu-dance allows many children to experience the excitement of performing in front of an audience but most importantly, it is promoted as a program for fitness and fun. Each year level has a program specifically designed to suit their age group, with appropriate music to complement each group. All staff employed by Edu-dance are thoroughly trained, qualified dance specialists and have many years of experience as both performers and teachers.

Each class will participate in 9 x 30-minute lessons each week, and a concert will be held to showcase their dances after the program. More details regarding the concerts can be viewed on the school's website, along with each class's session times.

Lessons for individual classes will be in Term 2, Monday (starting Weeks 2 to 11- not Week 8), Tuesday (starting Weeks 2 to 10), and Wednesday (starting Weeks 2 to 10).

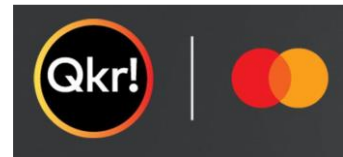
The program's cost is \$39 per student, and it would be appreciated if payment can be received at the office by Friday 28th March
