




Forest Crescent PS is taking part in National Walk Safely to School Day this Friday! Students have several fun ways to get involved.

1. Students and parents can join one of our walking school bus routes. What's a walking school bus? A Walking School Bus is a school bus powered not by an engine but by legs. Children don't sit inside this 'bus' – they walk in a group to school, with an adult 'driver' in the front and an adult 'conductor' at the rear. The walkers are the bus.
